Subject: Region 10 Regional Response Team (RRT10) Co-Chair Update

Nearly two years ago, the RRT10 agreed to implement the Pacific Northwest Oil and Hazardous Substances Spill Contingency Planning Framework. This agreement included a shared commitment to develop a standalone Northwest Regional Contingency Plan, to improve the existing Coastal Area Contingency Plans, and to create a standalone Inland Area Contingency Plan.

We are proud to announce that these plans are nearing completion and will soon be ready for public comment. We value feedback from the Pacific Northwest response community and urge you to visit www.rrt10nwac.com to find out how to provide input to our draft plans. The plans will be ready for review at different times throughout the summer, so we recommend you visit our website often for updates to the review process. The window for public comment opportunities will also be sent out via our Constant Contact distribution lists.

As the RRT10 Co-Chairs, we thank the Regionwide Planning Committee and the Area Committees for their hard work in reaching this considerable milestone. Once the review process is complete and all comments are adjudicated, we will finalize our plans and prepare them for signature. We are on track to promulgate our plans by October of this year.
