





Total Snowfall






KINDER MORGAN

January 22

KINDER MORGAN

- Release discovered at 0550 on 22 January
 2016
- Taking delivery of Jet A/Kerosene from pipeline
- Product to Tank 6 instead of Tank 15
- Released ~75,000 gallons into secondary containment
- Wildlife impacts





DVP & ROACHES RUN

- Transformer ruptured on 24 January
- Released 13,500 gallons of mineral oil
- Recovered ~13,000 gallons of free product
- Some oil was entrained in excavated soils/gravel
- On 3 February, "mystery sheen" identified on Roaches Run & Potomac River
- Wildlife impacts
