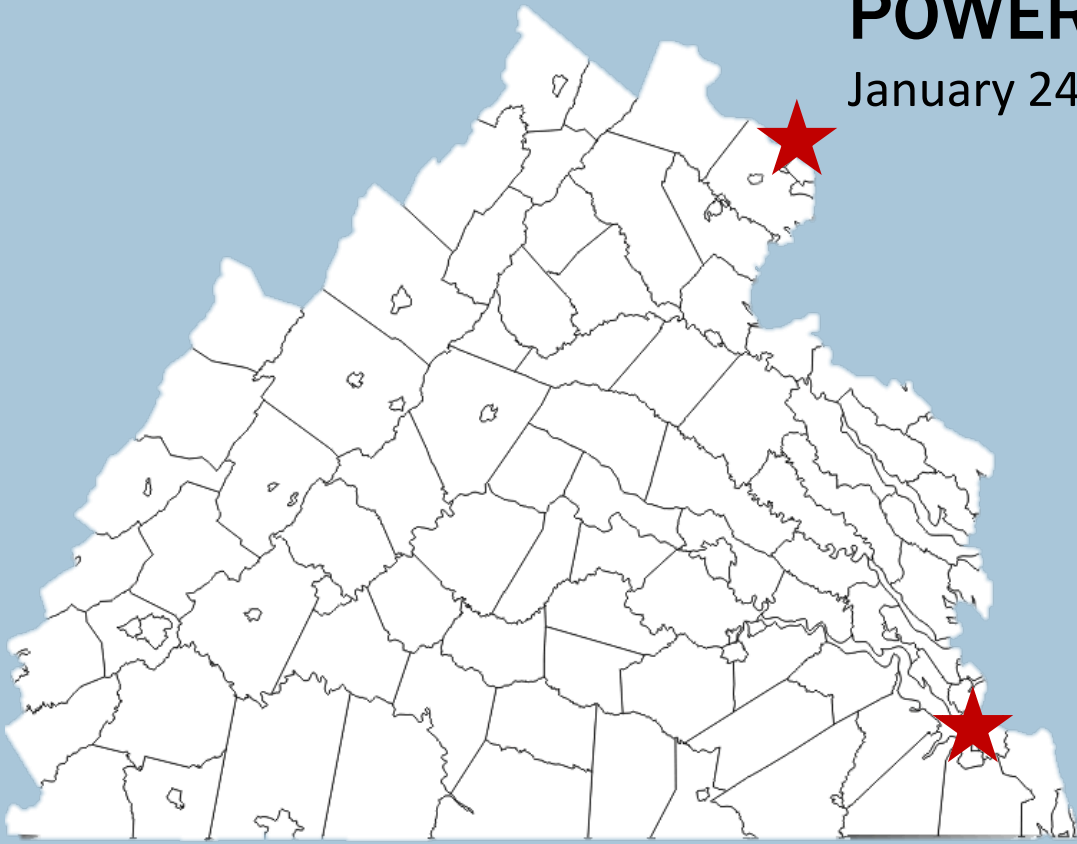

KINDER MORGAN

- Release discovered at 0550 on **22 January 2016**
- Taking delivery of **Jet A/Kerosene** from pipeline
- Product to **Tank 6** instead of Tank 15
- Released **~75,000 gallons** into **secondary containment**
- Wildlife impacts

DVP & ROACHES RUN

- Transformer ruptured on **24 January**
- **Released 13,500 gallons of mineral oil**
- **Recovered ~13,000 gallons of free product**
- Some oil was entrained in excavated soils/gravel
- On **3 February**, “**mystery sheen**” identified on Roaches Run & Potomac River
- Wildlife impacts
