

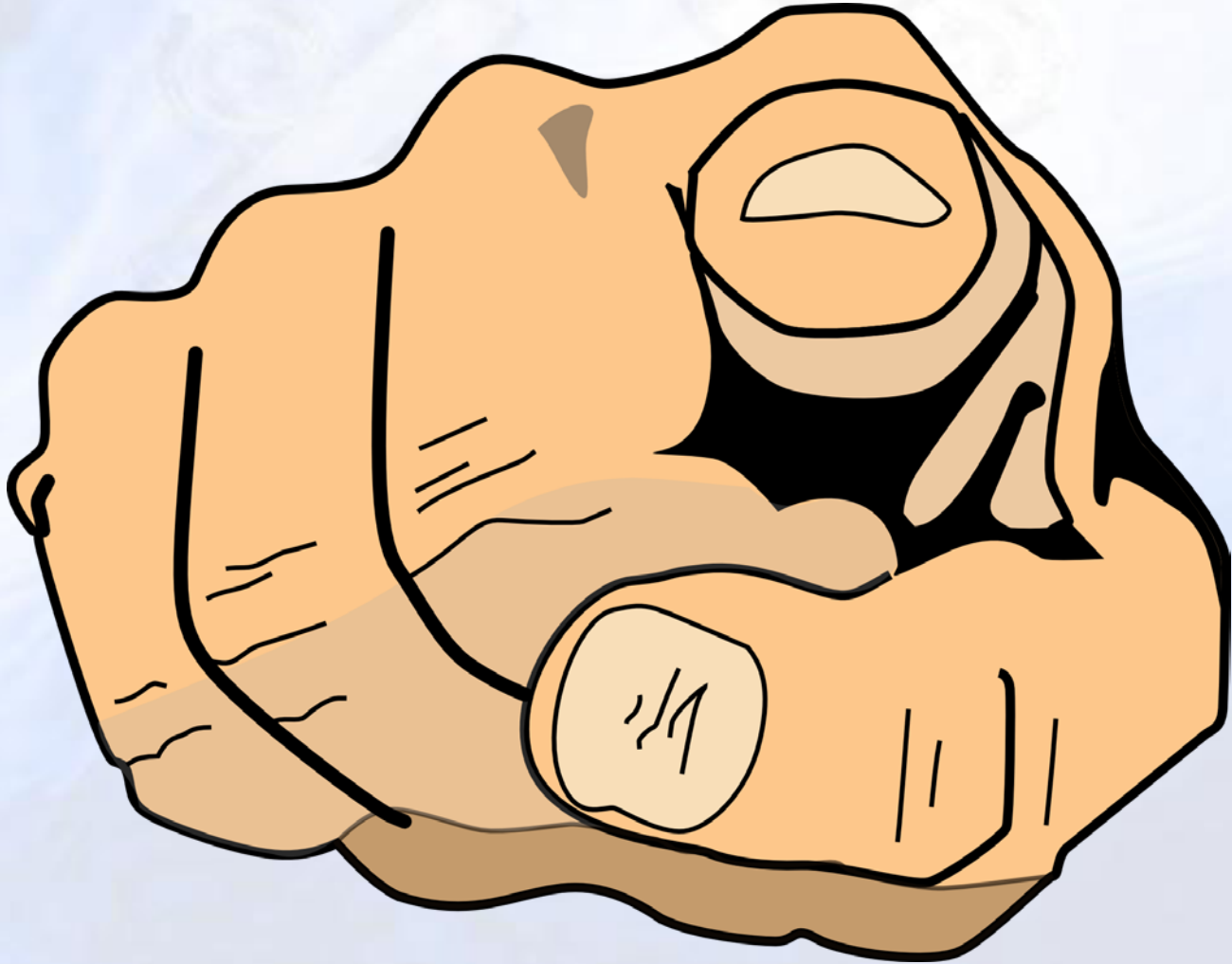

The NY/NJ Area Committee (AC) community on Homeport is a secure information dissemination platform designed to enhance collaboration through the announcement of meetings and postings of events and relevant information, and houses contact information among members and agencies, as well as the Area Contingency Plan.

The NY/NJ AC fosters cooperative bridge-building between agencies and port partners and reifies their mutual interests in contingency planning and pollution mitigation.

The goal of the AC is to foster interagency cooperation and mutual support in the unified efforts to plan for contingencies and mitigate incidents that pose threats to the environment and the port's natural resources.

Subcommittees within the AC streamline contingency planning and incident response efforts and increase the efficiency of the AC's mission and the implementation of the Area Contingency Plan.

- Established in 2005 to facilitate compliance with the requirements set forth in the Maritime Transportation Security Act (MTSA) of 2002, by providing:
 - secure information dissemination
 - advanced collaboration
 - electronic submission and approval for vessel and facility security plans
 - complex electronic and telecommunication notification capabilities
